

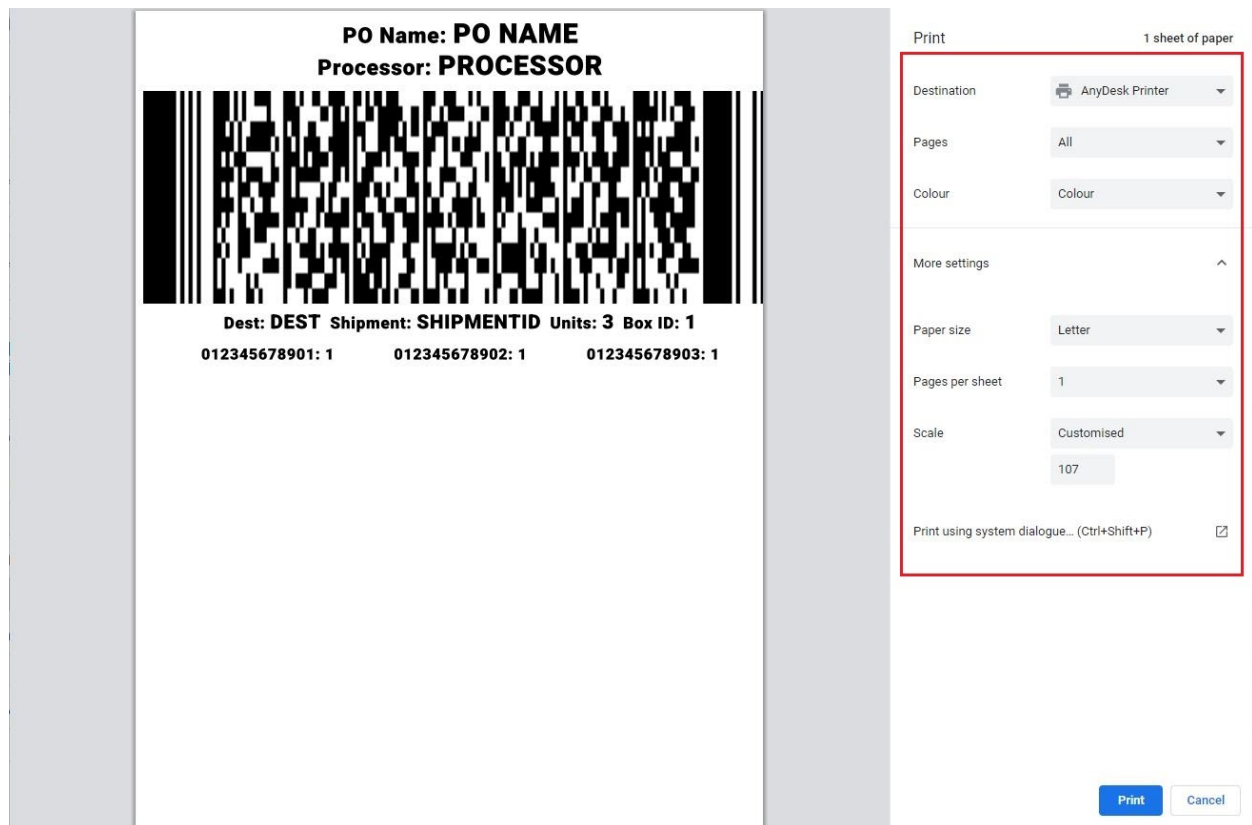
Select Default Printer

Learn how to set a default printer for your labels.

Decide between two options for printing labels

There are two options for printing labels through 2D Transit: printing through your browser or printing through PrintNode.

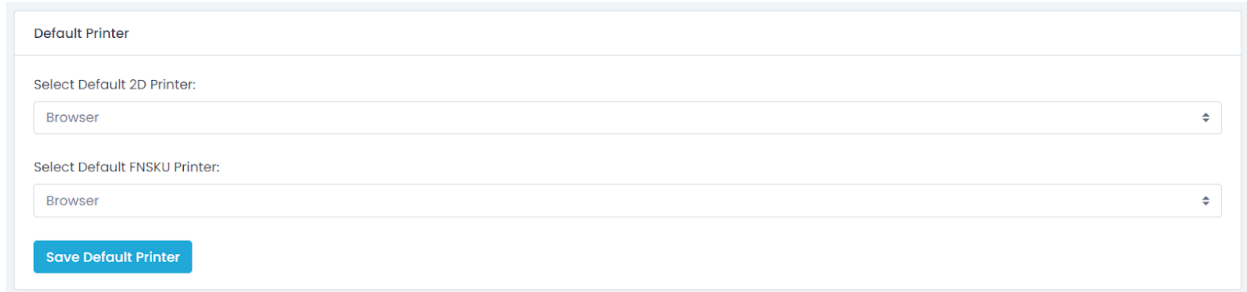
Printing through your browser is the default option if you change no settings. Clicking the **Print Label** button will trigger your browser's built-in printing pop-up window. From this window, you can select a printer from the available local or network printers installed on your machine. If you don't see your printer listed in the pop-up window, follow the manufacturer's setup or troubleshooting guide for your operating system.



Printing through PrintNode allows you to print labels through the Internet rather than through a local network. It is useful for printing labels remotely or from several different warehouses. To print through PrintNode, follow our guide to [set up PrintNode](#) printers.

Select a default printer for your labels

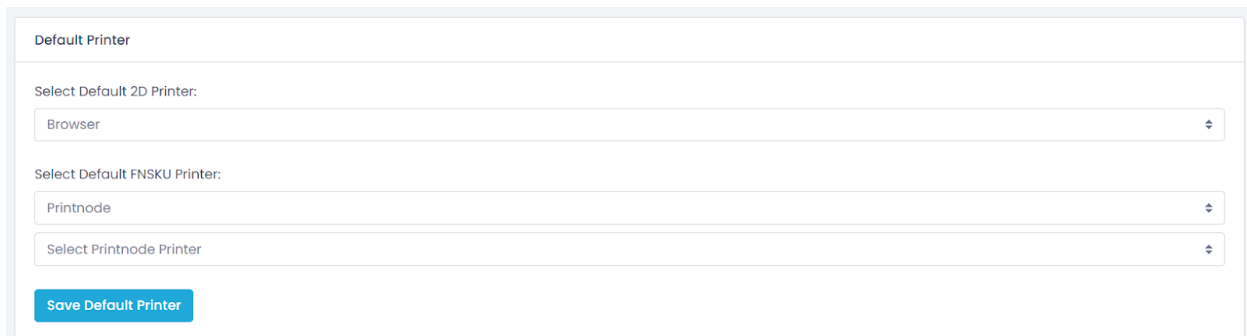
Navigate to the [Default Printer page](#) using the left navigation menu on the 2D Transit site.
